CHILDREN'S PROGRAM/CHILDCARE

Kol Ami offers High Holy Day educational programs for our children ages 3 and older. Under the direction Anne Hromadka and our counselors, we will create fun and exciting activities for our children to explore their Jewishness while observing the High Holy Days. A light lunch will be served, however, if your child(ren) have special food needs, please bring lunch and snacks for them. There is a nominal fee of \$5 per child per service for childcare.

CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Children's Services will be held at 10:30 AM on both Rosh Hashanah (Day One only) and Yom Kippur.
